



Important Registration Information:

You may register for camp online at meadowridge.org/summer-camp/

The registration deadline is one week prior to camp week. When registering online, you MUST complete these two items:

- 1) Camper Registration and Medical Form
- 2) Church Van Youth Permission Form

Important: Your child MUST have completed medical forms before they will be allowed to attend camp. If you have questions or need further assistance please contact us immediately.

Information Concerning Chaperones: A

chaperone is required for every 4-7 campers. If you are bringing campers of both genders to camp, please enlist at least one chaperone of each gender to accompany your group. The Chaperone Application Form (Authorization and Request for Criminal Records Form) should be completed by all chaperones attending camp. Chaperones must be at least 21 years of age. All Chaperones will receive an email link to the child protection course which is a 1½ hour training followed by an assessment. Each chaperone will need to pass the assessment to be allowed to serve as a chaperone.

What to bring: A Bible (if you don't have one, we will provide one), notebook, pen or pencil, sleeping bag (for twin size bed) and pillow, towels, washcloths, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste and any other personal hygiene products you might need.
